STAVEBANK ROAD AND LAKESHORE ROAD EAST INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

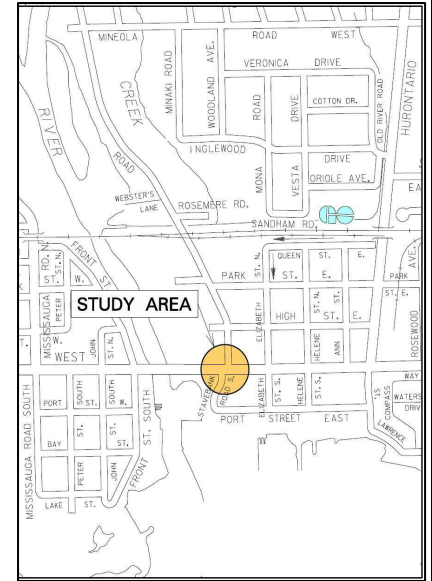
The City of Mississauga has completed a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study to investigate improvements to the Stavebank Road and Lakeshore Road East intersection. The study area is restricted to the immediate vicinity of Stavebank Road and Lakeshore Road East intersection, which is presented in the adjacent key plan.

The study was conducted in accordance with the planning and design process for Schedule "B" projects as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association "*Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007)*", which is approved under the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act*.

Following the Public Information Centre on June 23rd, 2009 the preliminary recommended alternative was reviewed in light of comments received and confirmed. The preferred alternative includes:

- Re-alignment of Stavebank Road South to better align with the north approach with minimal impact to Lakeshore Road East.

If concerns regarding this project cannot be resolved through discussions with the City, a person or party may make a written request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order). Written requests for a Part II Order must be received by the Minister at the address below by Friday, October 30, 2009. A copy of the written request must also be sent to either of the above listed City representatives. If no request is received by Friday, October 30, 2009, the City of Mississauga intends to proceed with the detail design and construction as outlined in the Project File Report.
